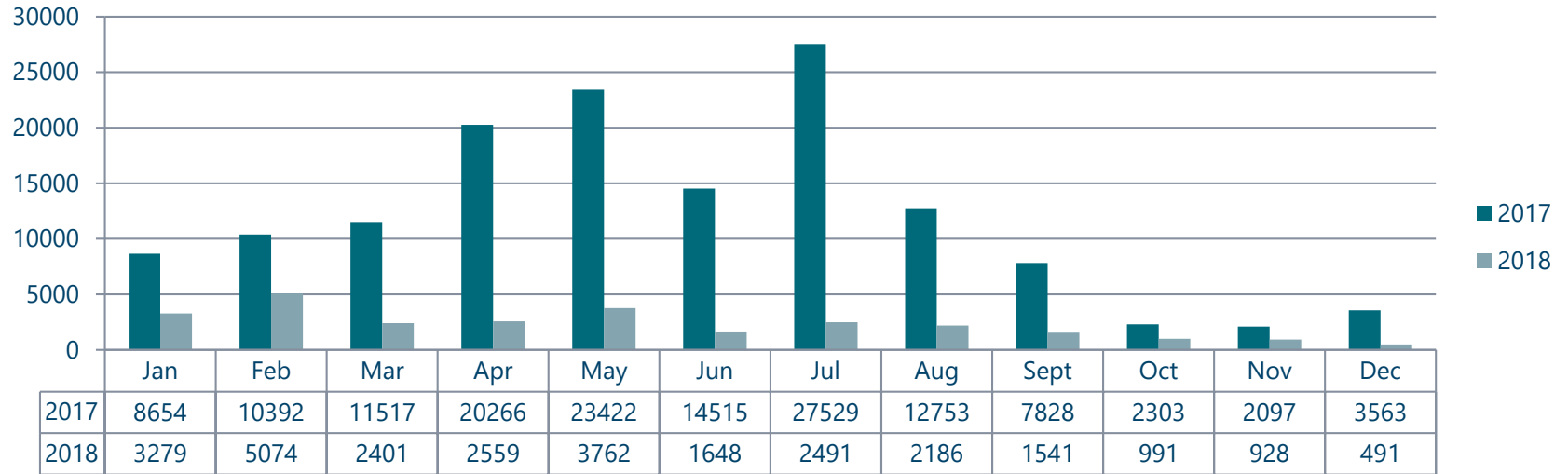

## Number of Complaints per Month



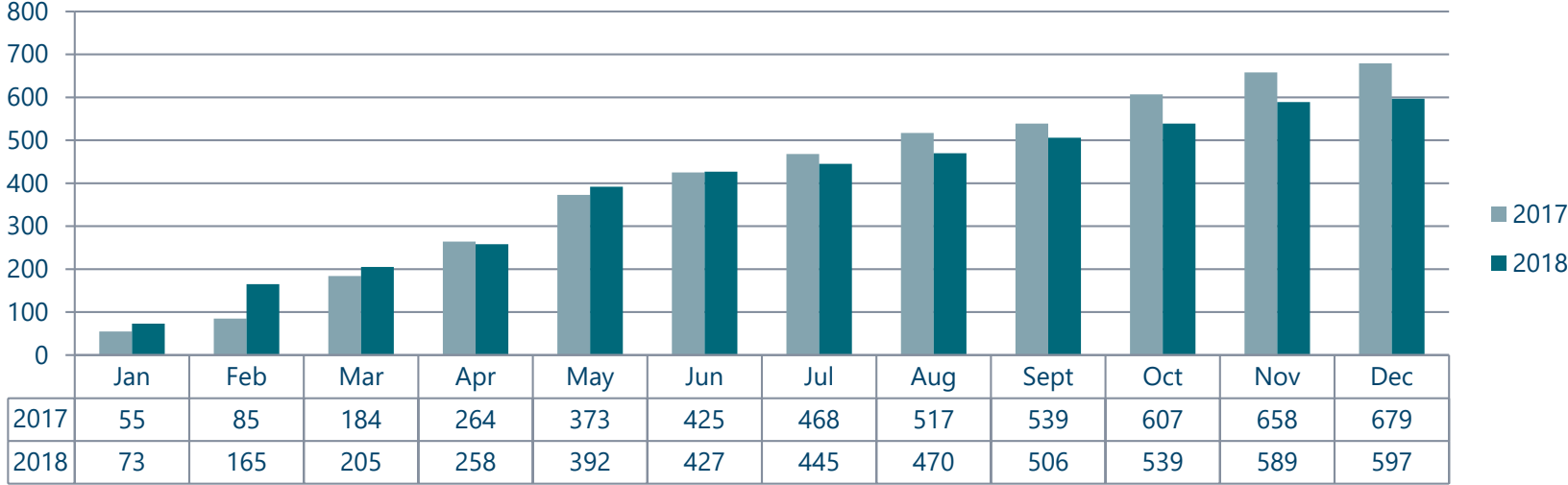
Totals:

# Complaint Stats continued

- Total 27,351 complaints from 597 residents
  - 25 residents account for 88% of all complaints
  - 1 resident submitted 1818 complaints, or 7% of total
- 2/3 of all complainants issued just 1 complaint for entire year
- Only 55 residents submitted over 20 complaints
